Summary

This document describes the Reserves policy for Berkshire County Scout Council (BCSC).

Reserves procedure

1. Berkshire County Scout Council operates a Reserves policy based on a risk management process which forms an integral part of its strategic planning. The reserves held and the risks associated with the projected income, expenditure, and activities, of Berkshire Scouts are reviewed on a regular basis by the CEC. This review is discussed and approval sought at each of the bimonthly Trustee Meetings as a standing agenda item. The Trustees seek to hold the minimum reserves which is commensurate with the required programme to deliver 'even better scouting for even more young people across Berkshire' for the next five years on a rolling basis.
2. The monies held as reserves are invested in accordance with the Investment procedure.
