Funding for second building

Our fundraising efforts from *Malawi* 2024 have given us the opportunity to fund a second building project.

We will therefore be supporting <u>Joshua</u> with a second classroom (an extension to an existing building) at one of their other community care centres at Solomoni, near to Blantyre airport. Work is due to commence imminently.

The photograph below is the community care centre at Milo (partly built and fully funded by Berkshire Scouts during the summer of 2024).




The building above is the community care centre at Solomoni. Berkshire Scouts are funding the building of an extension (second classroom).
